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Cambodia 2015 Report

- Kdei Karuna Follow-up Forum Training

RtR facilitator George Wielgus was joined by associate artist Maysoun Bouga to deliver a follow-up training session with reconciliation charity Kdei Karuna based on the work done with them in June and their subsequent experiences practicing the technique in the field. Over five days, working from 9am till 5pm, we deepened and explored problems faced by 10 participants using the technique. Feedback forms from these sessions are available and all scored 'very good' or higher. Details will be included in a further indepth report, along with photos collected during the sessions.

- YRDP Introduction To Forum Theatre

The YRDP Introductory course was attended over four days working 8.30am till 5pm with between 20 and 25 participants from a variety of NGOs and organisations across Phnom Penh and Cambodia. Responses were excellent, as was proven by the ffollowup attendance. The course followed our basic structure of developing participants to autonomy in the technique as rapidly as possible, a technique which was discussed as very effective by participants.

- YRDP Forum Theatre Follow-up

After a week's break, we returned to do the indepth training of trainers requested by YRDP, this time joined by associate artist Kean Soon Neoh of Malaysia aswell as Maysoun Bouga. Despite originally being told that we would be focusing on 10 YRDP members, response to the original programme was so high that we again were working with 20-25 participants for 4 days developing their skills and techniques.

- YRDP and Kdei Karuna Forum Friday

On the final Friday, we brought together the two different groups and performed five forum theatre pieces for each other, evaluating as we went. The pieces were effectively autonomously jokered and facilitated by participants on the course, with RtR representatives providing only warm-up games and a Q & A as the final part of the day.

- Manual on Forum Theatre

In addition to the workshops, CD GW produced a document of information to be distributed on the techniques and skills covered over the programme. It is attached here.

- Associate Artist Development Programme

In addition to designing and implementing the programme, a significant part of the project involved the training of potential future RtR facilitators in the deeper skills. This was a challenge.
